What could a group of young adults from the McHenry High School Bridges program possibly have in common with a group of seniors and their caregivers from Senior Services Associates?

More than you could possibly imagine.

At first glance, these two diverse groups seem worlds apart. **Yet**, **thanks to you and your support**, they came together at the farm last fall to spend time with our horses, animals, and with each other. Through these interactions, they discovered a common dialogue that transcended the generational divide, opening the door to creating meaningful connections.

The *McHenry High School Bridges* program helps students with disabilities transition to independent living. They learn vocational skills and important life skills. The Bridges' teachers describe that unlike any other educational experience, Main Stay helps in many of these areas.

Learning how to feed and care for the animals teaches them how to nurture and feel compassion for others. Working together at the farm and with the animals teaches collaboration.

And, the best part is learning new skills, which gives them a sense of power and control. Many of the Bridges' students have experienced social isolation, having positive interactions with each other and the animals helps them feel successful and when they feel successful, they want more of it! Working with the Main Stay staff and animals, they gain the courage to make decisions for themselves empowering them day in and day out.
